



# Special Olympics World Unified Volleyball Cup, Poland 2025

Vision:



Through the common language of sports, cup aim is to encourage people with and without intellectual disabilities to break barriers and forge new friendships to help build a more welcoming and inclusive society.

Date & Place 4-9 October 2025, Katowice, POLAND



Combines players with (called Athletes) and without (called partners) intellectual disability on the same sports teams for training and competition. The goal is to break down barriers in the community and to build awareness and tolerance on and off the playing court

Teams: 8 men's teams & 8 woman's teams

Each Unified Sports Volley team (Competitive Model Team) must consist of: 6 athletes with ID, 6 unified partners, 3 coaches, 1 team's volleyball ambassador

Age group: Over 15 years old

Participants 192 Players + 48 Coaches + 16 Team's Volleyball Ambassadors

70 Staff & Officials, Volunteers

Other participants: School-age children (500), Family members (100), Guests (100), Media (30)

Program: 4 Oct: arrivals, trainings, head coaches meeting;

5 Oct : qualification matches, Opening Ceremony 6 Oct: group matches, Young Athletes, Workshop,

7 Oct: group matches, social event

8 Oct: finals, awards and closing ceremonies;

9 Oct: departures

#### **TRANSPORTATION**
