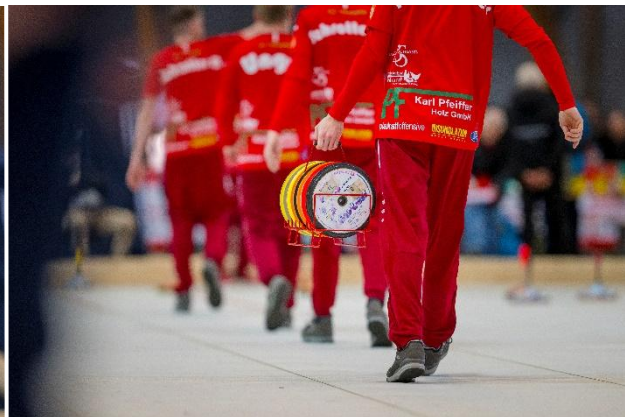

Data & Facts

Date & Location:

- 10/03/2025 5pm-7pm open practice (only with registration)
- 10/04/2025, 9am - 5pm (9pm optional)
- Competition venue: Neustift 3, 94036 Passau

Competitions:

- Team competition traditional (Level 3+4 or mixed)
- Team competition traditional (Level 1+2)
- Team competition unified
- Duo team competition traditional (Level 1+2)
- One Team consists of 4 people: either 4 Special Olympics athletes form a traditional team or 2-3 Special Olympics athletes plus 1-2 unified partners form a unified team
- Duos consist of 2 Special Olympics athletes → Based on the amount of registrations, two duos can be combined into one traditional team. The affected duos will be informed prior to competition.
- During unified competition, the unified partners have to execute the first trial whereas the Special Olympics athletes perform the last trial.

Number of participants:

- Capacity: 6 groups à 5 teams / duos
- Participants from SO Germany: 20 teams / duos
- Participants from max. 4 foreign Special Olympics programs: 10 teams / duos
- Registration occurs according to first come – first serve meaning that the order of registration determines the quota.
- Each delegation can register more than one team.
- Each delegation first receives one quota (first come – first serve) in order to enable as many delegations as possible to participate. If the total amount of registrations does not exceed the capacity, the remaining teams will be admitted to competition – again according to the order of registration.

Requirements for participating:

- Minimal age: 15 years

**Equipment:**

- Sticks of type M, L, P and E
- Level 1: white (with grey, black and green frame), red (profile running plate), green, black, grey and yellow colored plates
- Level 2-4: white (with grey, black and green frame), red (profile running plate) and green colored plates
- Having the required equipment is the delegation's responsibility. However, SO Germany is able to provide equipment in case its needed. Please contact in advance!
